Changes to our energy bills offer a prime opportunity for scammers. Some older people may need to take action by claiming Pension Credit to continue receiving the annual payment of either £200 or £300. Changes like this can provide an easy cover story for scammers. That's why Which? is warning people to be extremely wary of calls, texts and emails claiming to be from your energy supplier, the government or Ofgem. If you're in any doubt, avoid clicking on links in messages and contact your supplier directly using the details on your bill – or go to Gov.uk for more info.
